




How did people respond?

Q.2: How responsive are the adults at school to student ideas?






Q.1: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: You feel unsure about how to communicate with the school?


Q.2: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: The school provides little information about involvement opportunities?


Q.3: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: The school is not welcoming to parents?







Q.1: How motivating are the classroom lessons at your child's school?




Q.2: To what extent do you think that children enjoy going to your child's school?










Q.3: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his/her school?






Q.1: How often do you worry about violence at your child's school?


Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your child's school will bully him/her online?


